

Graduation Rates – Student Athletes

McKendree University is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates for student athletes. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended.

Graduation Rates are calculated based on parameters defined by the US Department of Education and must be reported annually to the National Center for Educational Statistics (IPEDS). Each fall, all first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates form a cohort. Student athletes in the cohort are tracked for 150% of the normal time of their program (6-years) to see how many complete their degree.
